# What is the EJCN ?



- Established by the Council Conclusions of 9 June 2016
- It is a Network of Judicial Authorities specialized in cybercrime, cyber-enabled crime and investigations in cyberspace
- Contact Points from EU Member States plus CH, NO, RS and USA
- Objectives : Provide access and disseminate information, including via specialized trainings, on cybercrime, digital evidence, cryptocurrencies, be a forum for discussions of practical and legal problems, promote the use of Eurojust in cross-border cases
- Hosted and supported by Eurojust

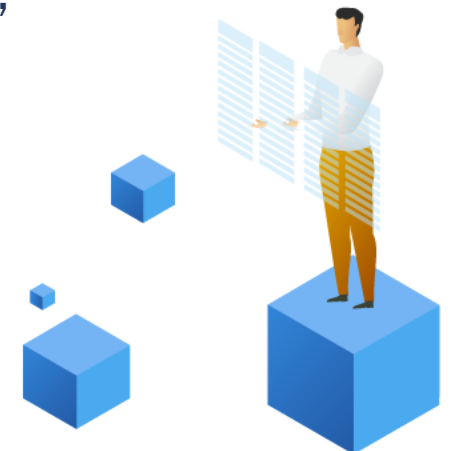

# Everything is Cybercrime?

## Digital Revolution

- The borders of what is cybercrime have expanded, potentially every criminal activity as a cyber or digital evidence element
- Need to identify the most common topics in cybercrime and cyber enabled crime, extending a minimum level of knowledge on digital evidence, cybercrime and cryptocurrencies to the judiciary as a whole
- Knowledge in Levels

Basic – Everyone

Medium – Specialized Prosecutors and Investigating Judges

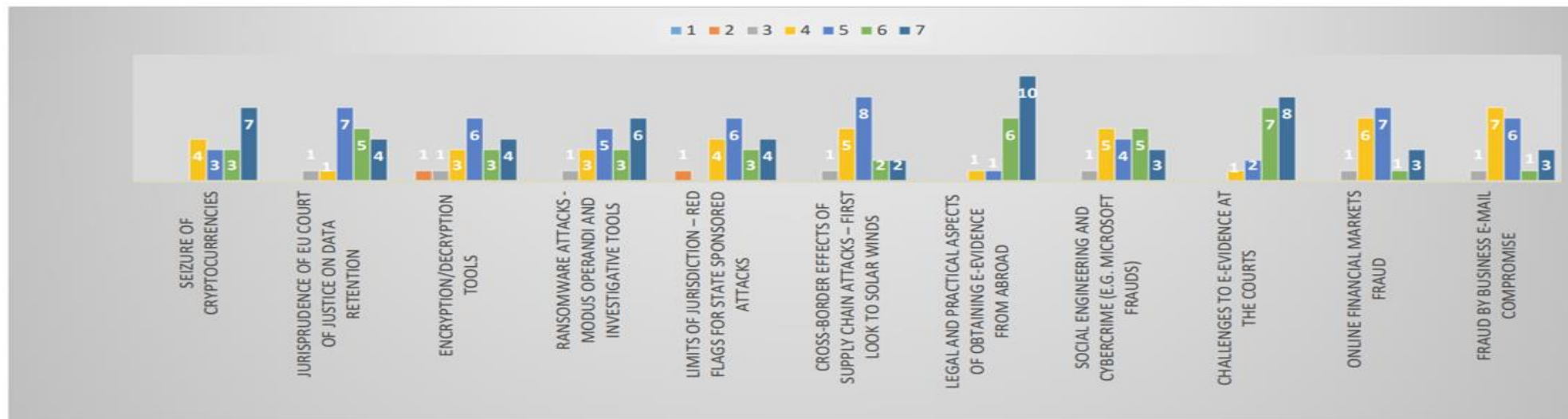
Specialized – Prosecutors in Cyber Units
